Charging your EV is easy

SUMMERLAND'S EV CHARGERS

The District of Summerland is investing in the future of electric vehicles. There are now 25 District charging stations at five charging locations throughout Summerland. The community offers cafes and shopping or scenic lake walks while you charge.

CHARGING ETIQUETTE

- When you're done, put the charging cord away so people don't trip or drive over it. And please keep the station tidy.
- You don't have to stay at your car while charging but do monitor the status through your charging app, and move your vehicle once finished.
- Don't unplug others, unless there is a note that gives you permission.



HOW TO CHARGE

- 1** Download and open an EV charging app to find an available charging station. Summerland has both Level 2 and Level 3 stations.
- 2** Once parked at the station, choose your station in the app and select Start Session. Alternatively use your RFID card and tap directly on the charging station. At Level 3 stations, press the Start Session button once it starts to flash.
- 3** Once authorized, securely connect the station's charging connector to your vehicle. The station will read the information of your vehicle and charging will begin.
- 4** You can monitor your session from your smartphone app or on your vehicle's screen.
- 5** Once charging is complete, press the Stop Session Button (Level 3 stations only), and disconnect the charging cable from your vehicle.
- 6** Securely replace the connector and the cable on the charging station.
- 7** A summary of your session will be sent via email or through your account on your app.

TYPES OF CHARGERS

Level 1 (Regular outlet): Slowest charge. Recharge commuting usage while at work or overnight.

Level 2 (Medium-speed station): Fully charge while at work or overnight, or recharge while shopping/visiting.

Level 3 (Fast-charging station): High powered station, fully charge in 30-40 minutes.



*Charging times depend on battery size and state of charge when you plug in.

FIND A CHARGER

Visit the [ChargeHub](#) or [PlugShare](#) websites or download their apps to find public charging stations and see what is available. Filter for specific types and view feedback from other drivers.

Download [A Better Route Planner](#) app to calculate the best places for you to charge based on your vehicle type and destination. It'll estimate how long it will take you and how much it will cost.

ACCESSING THE CHARGERS

To begin a session, charging stations require a RFID card or smartphone app that has been linked to a credit card.

Summerland's chargers are on the FLO network and using the FLO app or RFID card is recommended; however, an RFID card from any EV network will work.
