

Dear Mayor, Dear Council Members, Dear Staff Members,

I herewith submit to you the interim results of the petition of Summerlanders for Sensible Development opposing the High Density Development in the Bristow Valley (13610 Banks Crescent).

Essentially the petition was started in December after the November 14 council meeting.

The timing of the petition was difficult: We braved the cold in the coldest winter we have had in a long time and many people were absent, enjoying warmer climates south of the border.

Despite that difficult situation we collected 962 signatures until January 19th, and still ongoing.

Important is that those people that oppose this development come from all over Summerland and not just Lower Town. Although the proposed development will have a profound impact on the character of Lower Town, we strongly believe, as you know, that the development also has a profound impact on all of Summerland & beyond for the many reasons communicated to you earlier.

At one of your presentations about Economic Development last year, you gave me the impression that the proposed development was a done deal, except that you were still in talks with the Hatchery.

We, Summerlanders for Sensible Development do not think it is a done deal. We are here to help you with your decisions, so, please consult us!


