WHAT YOU SHOULD DO WHEN AN ALERT IS IN EFFECT

Upon notification of an **ALERT**, you should be prepared for the evacuation order by: Locating all family members or co-workers and designate a Reception Centre outside the evacuation area, should an evacuation be called while separated.

- Gathering essential items such as medications, eyeglasses, valuable papers (i.e. insurance), immediate care needs for dependents and, if you choose, keepsakes (photographs, etc.). Have these items readily available for quick departure.
- Preparing to move any disabled persons and/or children.
- Moving pets and livestock to a safe area.
- Arranging to transport your household members or co-workers in the event of an evacuation order. If you need transportation assistance from the area please call 250-486-3765.

- Arranging accommodation for your family if possible. In the event of an evacuation, the Reception Centre will be available to evacuees.
- Monitoring news sources for information on evacuation orders and locations of the Reception Centre.
