## Bylaw No. 2016-018, Amendment of Zoning Bylaw No. 2000-450 (RPN Zone)

The intent of Bylaw No. 2016-018, Amendment of Zoning Bylaw No. 2000-450 (RPN Zone) is to amend the density regulations in the RPN – Residential Pocket Neighbourhood Zone to permit developments that may have a greater number of units but remain under the Floor Area Ratio maximum.
