Zoning Bylaw Amendment (Water Zoning Regulations) Bylaw No. 2016-028

<u>Location:</u>	Foreshore out to the District of Summerland's municipal boundary in Okanagan Lake
<u>Legal:</u>	None
<u>Proposed Zoning:</u>	WZ1 – Recreational Water Use Zone 1 WZ2 – Recreational Water Use Zone 2 WZ3 – Intensive Water Use Zone
<u>Purpose:</u>	To consider adding water zoning regulations to the zoning bylaw to control land use along the foreshore and out to the municipal boundary in Okanagan Lake.
