



RECYCLING AMBASSADORS SUMMER STUDENT EMPLOYMENT

The District of Summerland is hiring two (2) outgoing students in the role of Recycling Ambassador for the period of May 1 to August 31, 2018. To be eligible, students must have been registered for full-time studies in the previous academic year and be returning as a full-time student in the next academic year.

These exempt positions include an hourly rate of \$17.00 per hour, which includes an allocation in lieu of benefits. The Ambassadors will be working 40 hours per week (including some time during evenings and weekends), and will assist with: presenting information on waste minimization and recycling programs to members of the public via social media, printed material, public events, and workshops; engaging other students and youth in waste reduction and recycling efforts; tracking the associated GHG emissions reductions resulting from waste reduction efforts; and other duties as assigned by the Sustainability / Alternative Energy Coordinator. Some training will be provided.

Qualifications:

- able to work independently and as part of a team
- friendly and professional
- possessing prioritizing and problem-solving skills
- organized and flexible
- pleasant persona coupled with sound judgment
- experience with Microsoft Office programs and social media platforms
- must have a valid driver's license
- must be under 30 years of age (as per the grant agreement through which these positions are funded)
- some minor lifting may be required
- an interest in sustainability and waste minimization, and knowledge thereof, is an asset but is not mandatory
