

## INTER-COMMUNITY BUSINESS LICENCE

Once you have purchased a regular business licence from the principle municipality you work out of, you may <u>also</u> be eligible to purchase an Inter-Community Business Licence. This licence allows you to work in all the participating communities listed below.

- -You must first have a valid regular business licence from the community in which you are located
- -The fee is \$150.00 and they are valid until Dec. 31<sup>st</sup> of the year you purchased it
- -You must perform a service within more than one participating Municipality or do business moving from client to client
- -No associated Premise (storefront) or location other than in your home or principal municipality
- -Some exceptions apply
