



Declaration of State of Local Emergency ORDER

WHEREAS a wildfire fire is imminent in the District of Summerland;

AND WHEREAS immediate danger to life and health safety exists;

AND WHEREAS this potential wildfire fire emergency requires prompt coordination of action or special regulation of persons or property to protect the health, safety or welfare of people or to limit damage to property;

NOW THEREFORE:

I DECLARE, pursuant to Section 95 (1) of the *Emergency and Disaster Management Act* that a state of local emergency exists in the Corporation of the District of Summerland due to wildfire and it poses imminent threat and potential harms to persons and property.

Per Section 97 (1) of the *Emergency and Disaster Management Act*, the state of local emergency will remain in force for fourteen days from today, August 7, 2026, until the end of August 21, 2026 unless cancelled by District of Summerland or the Minister of Emergency Management and Climate Readiness or extended by District of Summerland with the approval of the Minister of Emergency Management and Climate Readiness.
