


#### What is the SunMine?

- 1.05 MWp Solar farm located on reclaimed Teck mine site
- Enough to power ~200-300 homes
- 4032 solar panels on 96 trackers covering 5 acres

### **Goals and Objectives**

- Marketing!
  - Shed the mining town image
  - Create the image of a progressive community
  - Motivate people to check us out
- Re-purpose un-used land
- Not a short term economic development project
  - Minimal jobs, increased revenues
  - Long-term Potential







### How did we get here?

- In 2008, EcoSmart approached the City
- 2008-2011: scoping , test panels
- 2011: borrowing referendum, 76% in favour
- 2011-2014: planning, business case, RFP
- January 2014- April 2015: construction
- June 2015: commercial operation





## Financing - \$5.35M

- Original plan 2 MWp @ \$6.65M
- 1.05 MWp @ \$5.35M

City of Kimberley \$2M

Teck Resources \$2M

– ICE Fund \$1M

- CBT \$300,000

- SIDIT \$50,000

BC Hydro system upgrades



#### Results

- 18 agreements with 8 organizations
- 5.1% or \$271,000 over budget
- Completed 5 months behind schedule
- Over 1 yr commercial operation:
  - 1915 MWh of electricity sold to BC Hydro, 98% projections
  - \$195,700 in revenue, 91.6% of projections
  - Revised break even estimate \$171K/year before depreciation



#### Results

- 1,096 people toured the facility, including students from the local elementary, middle, and high school, as well as College of the Rockies and Selkirk College
- 178 media articles
- Project video has received 4,537 unique views
- SunMine.ca has seen over 13,000 unique visitors
