


Why?

 - Draft proofing
 - Hot water pipe insulation
 - Refrigerators
 - Insulation (attics, walls, crawl spaces)
 - Furnaces
 - Advice

Draftproofing and insulation




Home renovation rebate program

Rebates for:

- Insulation up to \$5500
- Furnaces and heat pumps up to \$2000
- Water heaters up to \$1000



New home construction rebates

Rebates up to \$8500 per home



Rental apartment buildings

- Direct installation of LED lighting, low-flow water measures
- Energy assessment
- Assistance to install common area equipment
- Rebates
- "Top-up" rebates for non-profit housing



Commercial/industrial rebates and incentives
