A proven ability to maintain effective working relationships with a variety of internal and external stakeholders, and present ideas effectively both verbally and in writing, are key requirements for this role to ensure a successful implementation of multiple projects and priorities. Several years experience overseeing an IT department, ideally within a municipal environment, as well as experience managing telecommunication systems and computer hardware and software in a networked environment is a must.
