Public Hearing #1 – Zoning Amendment: Retail Sales of Recreational Cannabis

Bylaw No. 2018-026

The intent of the proposed bylaw is to amend Zoning Bylaw 2000-450 Sections 11.5.2, BB1 – Central Business Zone and 11.6.2, CB2 – Shopping Centre Zone to include 'Retail Store, Licenced Cannabis' as a permitted principal use for the purpose of permitting the Retail Sale of Cannabis in those locations, provided that a referral from the province for retail cannabis licences has been received, considered and approved by council. Further amendments to the bylaw include the addition of definitions for 'Retail Store, Licensed Cannabis', 'Cannabis', and 'Cannabis Products' and amends the definitions of 'Retail Store, General' and 'Home Occupation' to prohibit cannabis sales where those uses are permitted.

The provincial licensing process requires that all applications for a retail cannabis store be approved by council resolution.

Public Hearing #2 - Zoning Amendment: Cannabis Production

Bylaw No. 2018-027

The intent of the application is to amend Zoning Bylaw 2000-450 Sections 12.1.2 M1 – Light Industrial Zone and 12.2.2 M2- Heavy Industrial Zone to include 'Cannabis, Licensed Production' as a permitted principal use. Further amendments to the bylaw include changes to Section 2.1 Definitions 'Agricultural, General' and addition of 'Cannabis, Licensed Production'.
