PROJECT: 2018-RFP-16 Cycling, Trails & Sidewalk Master Plans

The Request for Proposal documents for this work are revised as noted herein. All such revisions become a part of the work and shall be included in your Proposal. No consideration will be allowed for extras due to the Contractor not being familiar with this addendum.

1. REFERENCE: Answers to Questions Received

The following are answers to questions received:

Q1	Does the District have an inventory of existing sidewalk and bicycle network data in GIS or CAD?
A1	The weblink that was included in the RFP document which provided the Summerland Trails Inventory (section 2.2.e)) has been updated to also include sidewalk inventory. See link here . Bicycling network data is not available.
Q2	The RFP notes that Geotechnical considerations must be included. Can you provide more information regarding the level of detail and type of considerations anticipated?
A2	The RFP notes: "Consider various factors such as geotechnical, archeological, environmental, cultural and historical considerations". The level of detail and type of consideration is at a high level but should be considered when proposing the location of any future trail or sidewalk links and when estimating the capital costs of these.
Q3	Does the District have any specific stakeholder and public engagement program requirements?
А3	The District has identified that stakeholder and public engagement is required in the development of the Master Plans in this project. Submitted proposals should outline how the respondent will implement the engagement.
Q4	The RFP notes consideration of factors such as geotech, archaeological, environmental, cultural and historical consideration. Is it correct to assume that this would entail review and consideration of existing available information not development of new information by specialists?
A4	Yes, that is correct. See A2 above. Recommendations in the Master Plan may identify development of new information around these considerations that should be conducted in the future.
