



## CURBSIDE COLLECTION DAY

## FOOD / YARD WASTE

Green Lid  
WEEKLY collection

### PREPARATION

- All material must fit in the cart with the lid fully closed.
- To avoid conflicts with wildlife, DO NOT place your cart out before 5:00am on your collection day. Always store food waste in a secured/enclosed area.

### ACCEPTED FOOD/YARD WASTE

- ✓ Fruits & vegetables (remove stickers)
- ✓ All cooked and uncooked foods
- ✓ Meat, bones, food scraps
- ✓ Food soiled paper (napkins, coffee filters)
- ✓ Paper bags and food soiled newspaper
- ✓ Grass clippings and leaves
- ✓ Weeds and plant trimmings
- ✓ Prunings and branches up to 5cm (2in) diameter and less than 1m (3ft) long
- ✓ Pine needles and cones
- ✓ Fruit tree droppings
- ✗ NO plastics including compostable plastic
- ✗ NO plastic bags including compostable bags

## GARBAGE

Black Lid  
BI-WEEKLY collection

### PREPARATION

- All material must be placed in the cart, with the lid fully closed.
- No yard & garden waste or recyclables.
- To avoid conflicts with wildlife, DO NOT place your cart out before 5:00am on your collection day. Always store garbage in a secured/enclosed area.

### ACCEPTED GARBAGE

- ✓ Regular garbage
- ✓ Diapers
- ✓ Animal waste, loose grit/sawdust (*must be bagged*)
- ✓ Cling wrap/cellophane
- ✓ Broken glass, mirror & ceramics (*wrap in cardboard before placing in cart*)
- ✗ NO demolition or construction materials
- ✗ NO hazardous materials or pressurized tanks

## RECYCLING

Blue Lid  
BI-WEEKLY collection

### PREPARATION

- Place all clean recyclables loosely in the cart with the lid fully closed.
- Never use bags or stuff materials inside each other.
- All cardboard/boxboard must fit inside the cart.
- Take all refundable beverage containers to a bottle depot. Glass bottles and jar containers are not accepted in curbside collection, but can be recycled at the Summerland Landfill Recycling Depot.

### ACCEPTED PAPER AND PACKAGING

- ✓ Mixed paper, newspaper and newspaper inserts, boxboard and cardboard (*no wax coated*)
- ✓ Shredded paper (*put in paper bag or cardboard box and place inside recycling cart*)
- ✓ Dry goods paper packaging
- ✓ Pizza boxes
- ✓ Cartons and paper cups
- ✓ Plastic bottles, jugs, jars and cups
- ✓ Plastic hard packaging
- ✓ Plastic garden pots and trays
- ✓ Plastic tubs, trays and clamshells
- ✓ Empty aerosol cans and caps
- ✓ Aluminum or steel cans
- ✓ Aluminum foil and foil containers
- ✓ Plastic single use utensils

**Extra Garbage or Yard Waste?**  
Tag-a-bag stickers can be purchased at Municipal Hall. Use plastic bags for garbage and paper bags for extra yard waste. Place the purchased sticker on the bag.

Display the tag-a-bag sticker clearly on each extra bag and place it at the curb along with your cart on your regular scheduled collection day for that material.

**How to Use Your Curbside Collection Carts**  
Place carts out no earlier than 5:00am on your collection day:  
**Close It**—Ensure the lid is securely closed.  
**Point It**—The arrow on the cart lid must point towards the road.  
**Place It**—Ensure at least 1m (3ft) of space on all sides and 3m (10ft) clearance above. No vehicles within 1.5m (5ft) of carts.

**Unlimited Yard Waste Collections (Twice a Year)**  
Place Yard Waste in kraft style paper bags or containers labelled "yard waste only". Bundle branches up to 5cm in diameter and up to 1m in length with string or twine. Bags, containers and bundles must weigh less than 25kg in weight. No limit to bags, containers or bundles placed out.



## What Can Go In The Green Cart!

Eggs, cheese, grains, rice, pasta

Fruits, vegetables, (remove stickers) coffee

Food soiled paper (napkins, coffee filters, paper tea bags, paper plates, food soiled paper bags)

Yard Waste, grass, leaves, prunings, pine needles
