## Council proposes 6.32% annualized utility rate increase

**SUMMERLAND** – Mayor and Council have proposed an overall 6.32% rate increase for the District's water, sewer and electrical utilities, effective January 1, 2026.

The rate increase would see a typical single-family home in Summerland pay \$17.90 per month more for utilities than they did in 2025.

The proposed increases are broken down as follows:

**Electrical** – \$9.66 per month, or a 6.22% increase to the electrical budget with two of the main contributors being a 4.78% Fortis wholesale rate increase as well as a \$150,000 increase to the dividend paid to the general fund.

**Water** – \$5.97 per month, or a 6.77% increase to the water budget with the two main contributors being a 5.0% increase to annual asset management water reserve contributions and initial debt payments to fund Victoria Road water main replacements which requires 0.33% of the overall rate increase.

**Sewer** – \$2.27 per month, or a 5.73% increase to the sanitary sewer budget with the main contributor being a 3.5% increase to annual asset management sewer reserve contributions.

The three utility budgets were considered by Council at a committee-of-the-whole meeting on October 29, 2025, and will be presented to the public at an in-person Open House on Thursday, November 13, 2025, starting at 5:00 pm at the George Ryga Arts Centre. The Open House will include a formal presentation starting at 6:00 pm followed by a question-and-answer period.

Council will consider public feedback to the proposed budgets and debate utility rate bylaws at the December 2, 2025, regular council meeting.
