Summerland Climbs in Rankings on Canada's Most Liveable Cities List

SUMMERLAND – The District of Summerland's position on the Globe and Mail's Most Liveable Cities List has increased by 170 slots on the Canada-wide ranking of 454 cities. Summerland now sits in the top 100 cities in Canada, with an overall ranking of #80. When ranked against other small cities, Summerland's position jumps up to #27.

Highlights of Summerland's ranking include:

- Ranked #5 in all of Canada in the "Community" category
- Residents experience 69% less likelihood of crime than the Canadian average in the "Public Safety" category

This annual list analyzes data from 454 Canadian cities using variables across a number of categories and variables including economy, housing, demographics, healthcare, safety, education, transportation and public amenities like parks and public spaces.
