Required Qualifications

1. EOCP certification in Wastewater Treatment at EOCP Level I, II, or III.
2. Completion of an accredited post-secondary program in Water/Wastewater Technology (or equivalent), plus related municipal experience and training in wastewater treatment is preferred.
3. A valid B.C. Driver's Licence – Class 5.

This is a CUPE full-time position that provides a competitive remuneration and benefits package. The pay will reflect the level of EOCP certification as per the CUPE Agreement: Level I - \$31.69, Level II – 33.54, Level III - \$35.11 (probation rates may apply for the first 6 months).
