The following are answers and amendments to the questions and comments received:

Q01	I cannot open the Additional Document attachment.
A01	The District has reattached the Additional Document – Contractor Safety Requirements
Q02	What are the quantities for the previous years?
Q02	Typically, we range from 700 – 950 per year. Quantities for previous years are:
	2014 – 943
	2015 – 681
	2016 – 795
	2017 – 878
Q03	The insurance liability levels in the RFP appear high and the cost of obtaining (ie.
	Pollution/Environmental Insurance at \$5,000,000) would be costly, if at all
	possible.
A03	The District has assessed the risk as medium-high, therefore the Insurance levels reflect
	the risk due to the Environmental aspect of the work. The General Services Agreement
	and Schedule A are attached as a "Sample".
	Should a proponent have concerns with the Insurance levels as requested, the District
	recommends that a proponent submit their proposal with two price proposals for the
	work: One with the Insurance levels that they currently have or are able to obtain and
	the Second with the Insurance levels that the District has indicated in the RFP and build
	the price of increasing Liability in the second proposed price.

2. Addition of Transfer and Ownership of Risk Clause:

Risk – the ownership and risk of the removed product transfers to the Contractor as soon they leave the District of Summerland Sanitary Landfill Site.
