A Permit issued for a firearm is subject to the following conditions:

- (a) No more than one Firearm may be discharged per parcel of land;
- (b) A Firearm must not be discharged from a location on the land described in the permit that permits the firearm's projectile to travel beyond the land's property lines; and
- (c) a Firearm may only be discharged between one-half hour after sunrise and one-half hour before sunset.

Guidelines for Acquiring a Firearms Permit:

- A Firearms Permit must be completed in full and submitted to Municipal Hall if you wish to discharge a firearm within the municipality. Firearms include guns, bows, spring guns or other devices that propel a projectile by means of compressed air, explosives, gas, or springs.
- The applicant must be:
 - an owner, member or guest of a gun, fish and game, wildlife or sportman organization which holds all required permits, licences and other approvals and will discharge a firearm on and over lands or premises owned or occupied by such organization; or
 - the owner or possessor of the property and requires protection of the property, trees, vineyards, crops or animals, on the property from birds and other predators.
- Applicant must be the holder of a valid hunting and species license and provide proof.
- The property must be in the designated agricultural area named in Schedule A of the Bylaw #96-048 and may be inspected by the Bylaw Officer before approval is granted.
- No more than 1 firearm per parcel of land may be discharged.
- A firearm must not be discharged from a location on the land described in the permit that permits the firearm's projectile to travel beyond the License Holder's property lines.
- The firearm may be discharged only between 1/2 hour after sunrise and 1/2 hour before sunset.
- No animal may be harvested out of hunting season unless permitted or approved by the conservation officer and only 1 deer may be harvested unless approved by the CO.
- After the application has been filled out it must go to the RCMP for their approval.
- The RCMP will retain a copy of the Firearms Permit for their records as well as return one to Municipal Hall with all signatures.
