Nature and Scope of Work

Reporting daily to the Works Foreman, the Pipefitter/Layer 2 installs and repairs domestic water connections, sanitary sewer connections, and undertakes water main repairs and maintenance.

Duties

1. Repairs, maintains, and installs storm sewer systems and related infrastructure.
2. Repairs, maintains, and installs sanitary sewer systems and related infrastructure.
3. Repairs, maintains, and installs water supply systems and related infrastructure.
4. Repairs and maintains fire hydrants.
5. Works with and directs equipment operators and labourers as required.
6. Operates and maintains specialized water and sewer tools and equipment.
7. Operates various types of mobile equipment as required.
8. Plans the installations, repairs, and maintenance of water and sewer utilities and arranges for materials, equipment, and supplies to complete tasks.
9. Performs gas, water, and sewer line locations as required.
10. Writes reports on work completed.
11. Performs other duties as assigned.

Required Skills and Knowledge

1. Must be in good physical condition and capable of handling heavy equipment.
2. Able to work in an environment related to wastewater collection and water distribution.
3. Thorough knowledge of WorkSafeBC and District of Summerland safety regulations and WorkSafeBC procedures related to the position.
4. Works well with peers and supervisors in a team environment and has good verbal and written communication skills.
5. Possesses good mechanical aptitude.
6. Possesses good knowledge of the use and maintenance of a variety of hand power tools related to the trade.
7. Must have experience in reading blueprints.

8. Must be able to communicate with the public in a courteous and polite manner.
9. Must be computer literate.

1. Successful completion of Grade 12 education or equivalent.
2. Water Distribution Level 1 certification through Environmental Operators Certification Program(EOCP).
3. Waste Water Collection Level 1 certification through Environmental Operators Certification Program(preferred).
4. Ground Disturbance Level 1 & level 2 certifications.
5. Two (2) years related field experience.
6. Gas line locate training.
7. Valid First Aid Certificate.
8. Valid B.C. Driver's Licence - Class 3 with air endorsement and a clean Driver's abstract.
