1. Reference: Answers to Questions Received

The following are answers to questions received:

Q1	What is the approved budget for this project?
A1	The approved budget for this project is \$55,000.
Q2	Are there any existing hydrologic and hydraulic models available for review for the successful proponent?
A2	No, there are no hydrologic or hydraulic models available. An inundation study was prepared in 2013 for the Garnet Dam which will be made available to all proponents as part of this addendum.
Q3	Is there available hydrometric information in Eneas Creek?
A3	Outflow data from Garnet Dam could be made available to the successful proponent.
Q4	Is LiDAR information available for the study area?
A4	The District currently has 1m AutoCAD contours that can be downloaded here: https://www.dropbox.com/s/avkyo59fcb9pf2r/Contours2012.zip?dl=0 The District is attempting to obtain any LiDAR from the Ministry of FLNRORD that was gathered in 2017 or 2018, which will be made available to the successful proponent.
Q5	Can we obtain a copy of the District’s GIS in preparation for the proposal?
