The District of Summerland's Compost is an effective and environmentally safe compost material ideally suited to a variety of gardening needs. It is available at the Summerland Landfill for 2 cents per kilogram (minimum charge \$2.00) or if you need a pickup truck load, we'll load your truck, approximately \$22.00 per pickup load.

How to Use the Screened Compost

- Flowerbeds
 1" or 2" mixed into the top 6" to 8" of soil
- Tubers and Bulbs 1 part compost to 4 parts soil
- Roses
 1 part compost to 3 parts soil when planting Topdress existing beds with up to 1" compost
- Vegetables
 1 part compost to 4 parts soil
- Trees and Shrubs 1 part compost to 4 parts soil when planting Topdress existing beds with 1/2" compost
- New Lawns
 2" rototilled into top 6" soil before seed or sod
- Old Lawns Topdress with up to 1/4" compost
- Containers
 1 part compost to 4 parts soil

The compost is made from bio-solids (processed sewage), grass, leaves, fruit, vegetables and wood chips. This product may be used as part of a complete fertilizer program that relates to the fertility level of the soil.
