Welcome to Peach Orchard Campground, the following rules and regulations are meant to ensure a safe, peaceful, and content vacation for your family and your camping neighbor. Failure of you or any member of your family/group to comply with these rules may result in eviction.

- Check-in between 2 pm and 8 pm. Check-out no later than 11 am. If guest wish to stay another night, please check with office by 10 am for approval and payment.
- Late check-outs without approval and payments will result in an additional fees and towing fees if necessary.
- Do not occupy another site. Even if the site is empty, you may not use another site for parking your vehicle or any other reason.
- No wood fires. Propane fires are allowed, however cannot be left unattended and must be turned off by 11 p.m.
- Ropes and nails are **not** permitted to be used on trees.
- Household garbage only is to be bagged and placed inside large blue bins outside washroom(s).
- Recycle (green bin) located next to garbage bins. Please rinse containers if necessary.
 Pop/alcohol/juice containers may be placed in smaller blue recycle bins in front of the men's washrooms.
- **Quiet Time** is enforced from 11pm to 8 am. No parties, music, or visitors between these hours. No public drunkenness/disorderly behavior at anytime on the campground property. Any violation may result in immediate eviction and if necessary, contact with the RCMP.
- Children must be always supervised in the campground and injuries, or property damage caused from lack of supervision is not the responsibility of the campground. All minor children (under 16) must be at their own site by 11 pm.
- Maximum 2 dogs per site. Dogs must always be on a leash, even at your campsite and are not permitted inside public buildings. Dogs are not to be left alone or unattended at your site (in a tent or RV). Barking will not be tolerated if your dog is bothering your

- neighbours, you may be asked to leave or muzzle your pet. Please clean up after your dog.
- Keep valuables and coolers inside your camping unit or vehicles; management is not responsible for theft or damage.
- Bathrooms are to be respected just as your own in your home. Washrooms are
 provided for personal hygiene tasks only. Dish washing, clothes washing and hair
 dyeing, toasters, rice cookers and other appliances are examples of unacceptable
 behavior and appliances. Cell phones, laptops, and all other electronic equipment are to
 be used at the charging station.
- Visitors must register at office before entering campground. Visitors' vehicles must be left in overflow parking lot and walk in. Visitors cannot stay overnight unless registered as a guest.
- Gates close from 11 pm to 7 am. Gates will only be opened for medical emergencies.
- Speeding Please drive as fast as you would walk. Violators will be asked to park in the overflow parking lot and walk in the campground.
- Out of respect for your neighbour, generators use is not recommended however if required, use is restricted to between 11:00 am and 2:00 pm.
- Due to the close proximity of sites, it is requested that cannabis use be consumed off premises in order to not impact your neighbour.
- Pickleball Courts 9 am to 9 pm, games room and laundry facilities 8 am to 9 pm.
- Boats are **not** permitted on site. Boats must be parked in the overflow parking lot across the street.
