COVID-19 FACILITY GUIDELINES
CENTRE STAGE THEATRE – USER GROUPS

All rentals must be booked through the District of Summerland Recreation department at 250-494-0447.

General

- Prior to use, renters are required to provide a COVID-19 Safety Plan. The BCRPA has provided a COVID-19 Safety Plan Template. The Safety Plan must be posted by the organization and/or available on-site during activities
- Maximum 50 people in the theatre per booking.
- Maintain 2 meters from others at all times (except transitory spaces such as hallways).
- Be mindful of common surfaces and limit touch points.
- Collect all garbage and recycling and place in appropriate receptacles.
- Hallways are shared, do not enter the hallway if someone is approaching from the opposite direction.
- Follow all on site signage.
- Please give the technician room to work, maintaining 2 meters distance at all times.

It is vital that we all be calm and compassionate throughout this pandemic. Any person who exhibits any aggression towards staff or any other person in our facility will be asked to leave and not return.

Illness Protocols

As per the BC Healthlink guidelines do not allow your participants to enter the arena facilities if they have:

- Experienced cold or flu-like symptoms within the last 10 days
- Been in close contact with anyone else who has had these symptoms in the last 14 days
- Been in close contact with anyone else who has travelled outside of Canada in the last 14 days
- If your child/participant is displaying symptoms of respiratory distress or illness, they will be asked to leave the facility & seek medical attention.

Safety Protocol

- Each rental group must have a volunteer or staff to supervise the group and ensure the participants, parents, and spectators are following the COVID-19 protocols while in the facility. This person must be a visible presence (e.g. arm band signifier) in the facility.

Personal Hygiene

- Please note that staff will be scheduled to clean/sanitize following the rental time.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose or mouth.
- Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue or into your elbow when coughing or sneezing.
- Wash or sanitize your hands often.
