Official Community Plan (OCP) Bylaw No. 2026-008

The intent of the proposed bylaw is to:

- Rescind the current OCP Bylaw No. 2014-002 and replace it with the proposed OCP Bylaw No. 2026-008. This replaces the current Official Community Plan that was adopted in 2015 with the draft Official Community Plan update.
- Meet the legislative requirement of incorporating the District's 20-year housing needs (as per the latest Housing Needs Report) into the updated OCP
- Key changes include: Updated context information, housing and population projections; adjusted Growth Boundary and six defined growth areas; updated land use designations and land use mapping; new policies on infrastructure, quality of life, and sustainability, as well as Development Permit Areas.
